GOOD DAY SPRING HILL

Our purpose in the "Good Day Spring Hill" program is to provide persons who live alone a secure feeling in knowing that someone is in contact with them daily and will provide them with help when needed.

Program participants are requested to call the police department each morning between 8:00am and 10:00am, Monday through Friday, to check in. If we do not hear from you by 10:00am, we will call you to make sure everything is all right.

If we still cannot reach you, we will send a police officer to your home to check on you. On Saturday and Sunday we will not be able to call you, but if you need an officer, you can call the after hours number of (913)592-2700 and dispatch will send an officer to your address. If the call is an emergency please call 911 instead of the after-hours number.

If you are interested in being a part of our "Good Day Spring Hill" program, please fill out the application form that is available online at www.springhillks.com and return it to the police department. It is very important that you provide us with all of the information requested so we can contact the necessary persons in the event of an emergency.

WATER TOWER IMPROVEMENTS 2014



In the Spring of 2014, the City of Spring Hill will be repairing and painting our 500,000 gallon elevated water tower. As with all public water infrastructure, the City of Spring Hill is required by Federal and State regulations to routinely maintain and repair it when necessary.

The City's elevated water tower is in need of repair and repainting on the interior and exterior of the tank. This project is tentatively scheduled to begin in April, with the duration of the project depending primarily on Spring weather conditions, but with an anticipated timeframe of 60 to 90 days to completion.

The tower will be taken out of service for the duration of the project. However, in anticipation of this repair project, the Public Works Utilities Staff has upgraded the water distribution pumping system and will be redirecting your water service supply to the City's smaller capacity ground storage tank.

We do not anticipate any disruption in water service, but in order to ensure minimal if any disruption, Spring Hill water customers are being asked to voluntarily conserve water throughout the duration of the project. (Note: This project does not impact RWD #7 or Water One customers.) Some water conservation tips are:

- Reduce the amount of water used on lawns, plants, and trees;
- If you plan on re-seeding or sodding your yard, please consider doing so in the Fall months;
- Check faucets, pipes, and toilets for leaks;
- Take shorter showers, and use your dishwasher and clothes washer for full loads only.
