Door-to-door soliciting is allowed in the City of Spring Hill. But if you'd prefer to not receive spontaneous visits from salespeople, there's a simple solution.

Free "No Soliciting" stickers are now available at City Hall. You can also print off a "No Soliciting" sign from www.springhillks.gov to display. Please be sure to display your sign or sticker so that it is clearly visible from your front door.

If you have posted a "No Soliciting" sign at your house and a solicitor ignores the notice, you may choose to report the solicitor to the Spring Hill Police Department by calling (913) 592-2700.

CLEAR SNOW ROUTES HELP CLEAR ROADS

When inclement weather occurs, our street crews focus on clearing the City's Emergency Snow Route first. Once that route is cleared, crews are dispatched to other areas of the city.

To help us clear city streets more quickly, it is important that residents do not park on streets within the Emergency Snow Route. These vehicles are subject to impoundment.

It's a good idea to avoid parking on the Emergency Snow Route whenever the forecast calls for snow or ice. You can view a map of the route at the City's website under Departments > Streets > Snow and Ice Removal.

FACILITY SUPERVISOR
